

## Research Data Ownership. Licensing, Legal Issues and Publication

An international seminar and workshop 10–11 June 2019

*Institutum Romanum Finlandiae, Passeggiata del Gianicolo 10, Rome*

The project *Academic Institutes Open Research Data* organizes a two-day seminar at the *Institutum Romanum Finlandiae*, June 10th and 11th 2019.

The theme of the seminar is ownership and licencing of research data, and this theme is discussed in presentations by experts in the archival, legal and classical fields. The theme is also discussed in the relation of the four pilots running under the main project, with practical issues and applications.

The speakers at the seminar are:

**Koraljka Guzman Šlogar** is the Head of the Archive, Institute of Ethnology and Folklore Research, Zagreb.

**Marjut Salokannel** (LL.D. docent) is a leading expert in data protection and privacy issues related to using sensitive personal data in a cross-border setting.

**Heli Kautonen** is the head of the Library, Finnish Literature Society.

**Barbara Mancini** is IT consult working for many foreign academies in Rome.

**Jonathan Prag** is the professor of Ancient History, Faculty of Classics, University of Oxford, also running the project *Inscriptiones Siciliae*.

In addition to the invited speakers, people working in the four pilots will present their work.

The pilot projects included in the seminar are:

1. Rome I: Segregated or Integrated? Living and Dying in the Harbour City of Ostia, 300 BCE – 700 CE
2. Rome II: Digitizing the *Bolli Doliari* database
3. Athens: Publishing archaeological data from the Gouriza site
4. Middle-East: Digitizing the Hilma Granqvist London archives

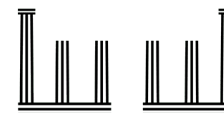
