Papers (20 minutes presentation) and posters can be submitted on various topics related to the conference theme, but we especially welcome contributions on:

- Reading gender structures in the Greco-Roman Societies
- Material and immaterial signs of status in everyday life
- Work structures and occupations
- Religious practices and identities
- Ethnicity, status, and identities
- Slavery and coersive work

Please submit an abstract (max.250 words) for a paper or a poster no later than **9 April 2023** to arachne@class.gu.se
